

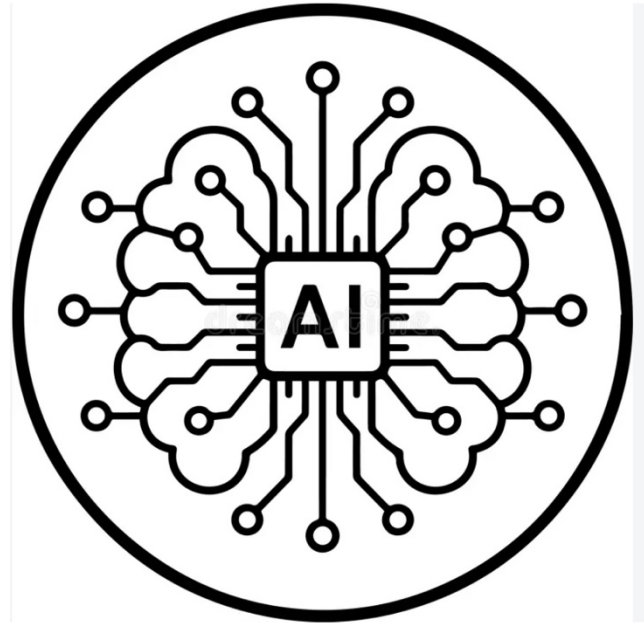
Artists: How to Survive the Enemy of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

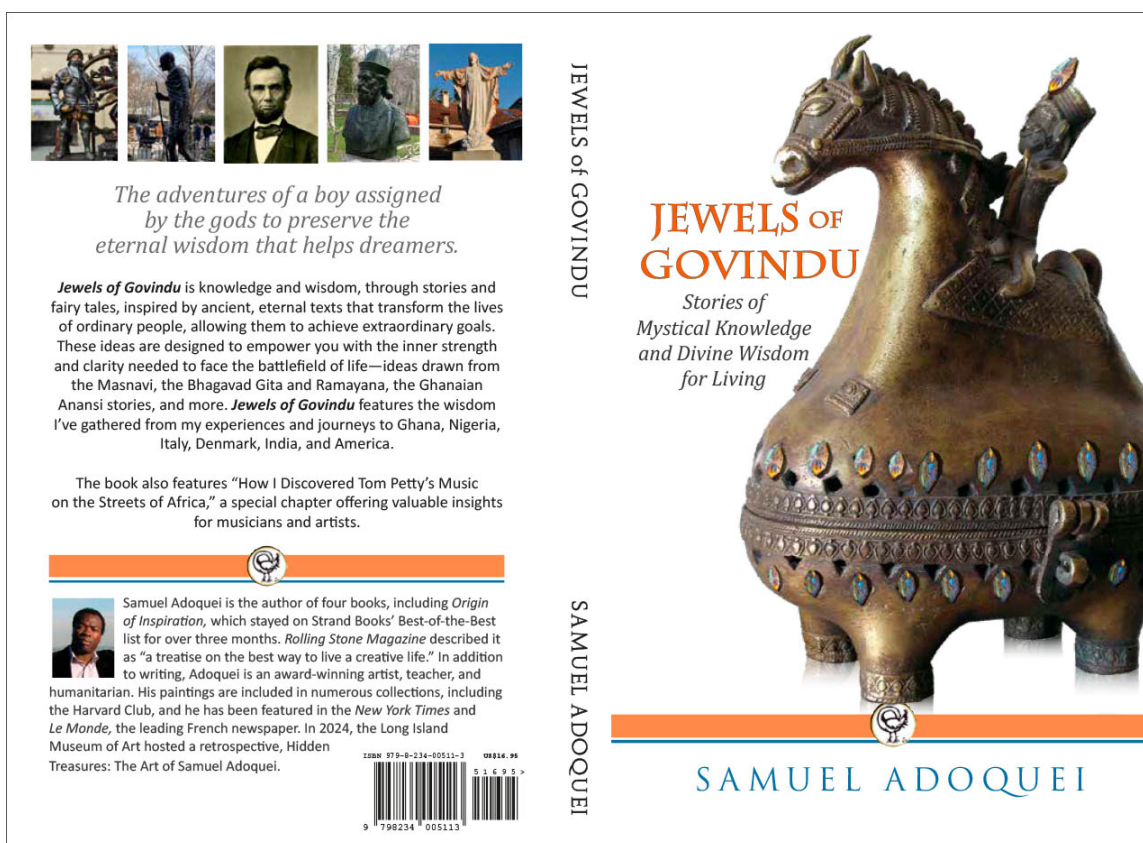
An understanding of humanity, influenced by divine laws, shields true artists from AI.
